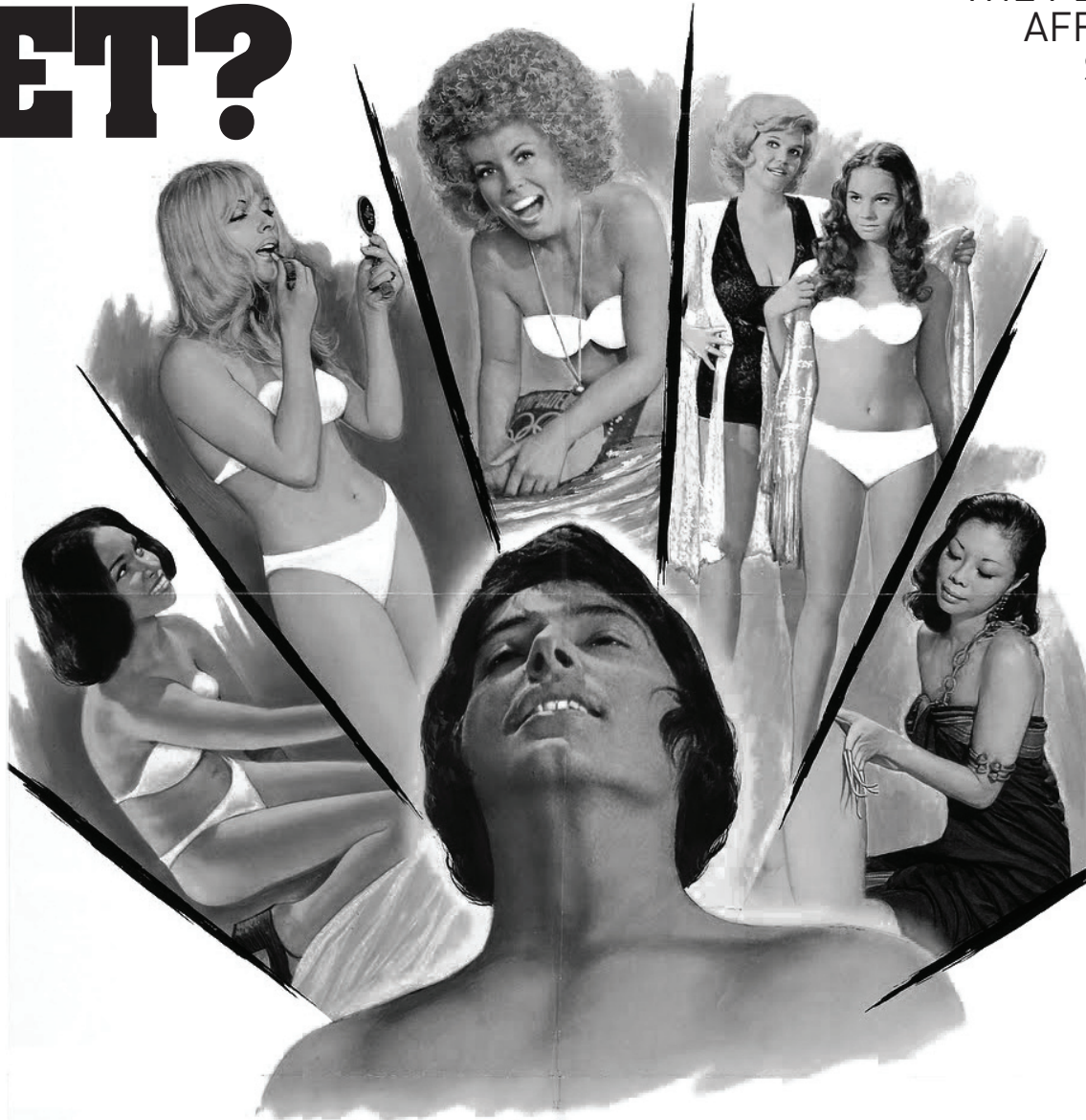

## A PANEL DISCUSSION ON FEMINISM, GAY RIGHTS, AND SEXUAL LIBERATION
